"Truths of Media"



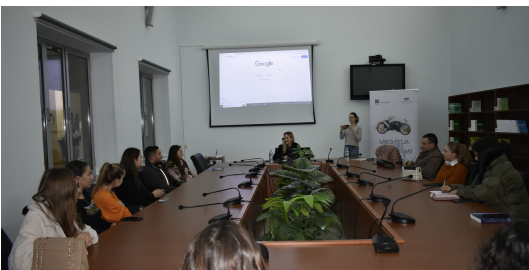
