# THE FORMAT OF THE PAPER

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The Second International Student Conference

## “EMBRACING DIVERSITY, INCLUSION AND MULTICULTURALISM”

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**The form of the paper:** The paper should be written in Microsoft® Office Word 2007. The length of the whole paper should be 3000 – 5000 words.

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**The official languages of the conference:** Albanian and English. Please, when writing the article in Albanian, avoid using foreign words. In the cases when it is obligatory, you have to write their translation in brackets or in “footnotes”. Make sure that your manuscript has gone through the spell and grammar check process before submission.

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**Form of writing:** Times New Roman, single line (justified)

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**Format of the paper:**

Font: 11  
Orientation: Portrait  
Page Layout - Size: B5(JIS), 7,17" x 10,12  
Page Layout - Margins: Moderate 1" x 1", 0,75" x 0,75"  
Text Alignment: Justified  
Line Spacing: 1,15

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Do not number the pages of your paper. Do not format the text into several columns. Do not use paragraphs. Empty/blank lines should be used only when needed. Do not use many spaces.

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**The organisation of the paper:**

The elements that should be included in the paper:

- Title, author/s and affiliation
- Abstract and key words
- Introduction/ Presentation
- Materials and methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Results/ Conclusions
- References
- Appendices (if applicable)

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**Title:** The title should be specific, concise, understandable and clear enough to convey the central idea of the paper to the readers. The title should be in capital letters, font size 14, bold. It should contain no more than 250 characters. The author (s) name (s), their affiliation(s) and their addresses should be centred and written after the title.

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**Author(s):** All the individuals who have given their valuable contribution in the article should be listed as authors. Please, write the author's name, surname and affiliation. The affiliation includes the study program, university or its location, city/town and country. Do not list academic titles, personal addresses and emails. The author(s) name (s) should be CAPITALISED, font size 12. The author(s) affiliation should be CAPITALISED, font size 10.

**Abstract:** The abstract should describe the main objective(s) of the study, explain the way the study was conducted and summarize the most important results. It should not extend 300 words and should not include citations. For the articles written in Albanian, the abstract should be in two languages: Albanian and English.

**Keywords:** The author should include 5-7 key words which reflect the core of the study. The key words or phrases should be separated with commas. Only names, surnames or abbreviations should be capitalised.

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**Titles and subtitles of the paper:** The titles should be capitalised, bold and placed below a blank line. The subtitles should be *italic*. They should be numbered by using Arabic numbers (1, 1.1, 1.2, 1.2.1..., 2, 2.1...). Try to limit the sections and sub sections of your manuscript into 3 title levels.

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The purpose of the Introduction is providing sufficient relevant background information to allow the readers to understand and evaluate the results of the present study. Clearly state the scientific problem investigated, the objectives of the work, the research conducted and the structure of the paper and provide an adequate background, avoiding detailed literature survey or a summary of the results.

**Theoretical background:** In this section of the paper a general description of literature is required. A good research work should be based on a theoretical framework which is predominant in a certain scientific field.

**Introduction** The statement of the problem and the purposes of the paper: the scientific problem should be stated clearly and correctly. The objectives of the paper should be harmonised with the problem. The statement of the problem should be meaningfully related to the theoretical framework and the hypothesis and predicted methods of research.

**Research questions and hypothesis:** The research question (s) should be stated clearly and concisely. It should include a hypothesis which can be verified or proved. Avoid ambiguity and other supplementary questions and write the hypothesis correctly. The findings of the paper should lead to the results.

A good quality research work should provide the readers with a correct description of the research phenomena which would further result into appropriate conclusions.

When using quantity research or a mix of quality and quantity research, it is necessary that the author (s) provide the readers with a set of defined criteria

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through which a hypothesis can be either confirmed or rejected.

**Materials and methods** should be provided in details. In this section the authors should include different methods used in the research and statistics too. The information should be sufficient so as to indicate the references.

**Results and discussions** should be clear and illustrated in charts and graphs. The experimental results should be analysed statistically and the results should be statistically reliable. Use either charts or graphs to show the results, avoid using both forms for the same results.

**Conclusions:** The conclusions should be fully discussed and they should be closely and directly related with the results and discussion section of the paper. They should be neither speculative, nor general spontaneous assumptions taken from previous consulted literature by the author(s).

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**Tables:** The tables should be positioned in the right place, apart from the text, between the paragraphs not inside them. All the tables should be numbered and labelled referring to the number of the table in the text. The number and the title of the table are to be labelled outside the table, above it and centrally positioned. Use Font size 10. Only the title should be **bold** whereas the description should be *italic*. Example: **Table1.** *General data of the research.*

The tables should be drawn in the Tables section of Microsoft Word and they should not include figures, objects or unnecessary blank spaces. The tables which are too long or wide to be put in a single page may be either written using a smaller font size or continue in the following page of the paper.

**Figures/images:** Figures/images which include graphs, charts, maps, drawings and photographs should not be used for decorative purposes, but they should materially influence the content of the paper. They should be positioned in the right place, apart from the text, between the paragraphs, not inside them. All the figures should be numbered and labelled referring to the number of the figure in the text. The number and the title of the figure are to be labelled outside the figure, above it and centrally positioned. Font size 10, only the title should be **bold** and the description in *italic*. Example: **Figure1.** *General data of the research.* The figures are to be high quality ones and they should lay in only a single page.

**Acronyms** Do not use nonstandard acronyms, if they do not appear at least three times in your text. Use acronyms as little as you can.

**Footnotes:** Footnotes are listed at the bottom of the page. They are used to cite references or comment on a certain part of the text written above. They refer to relevant sources - they let the reader know where certain material comes from, or where they can look for other sources on the subject.

**References:** The references are to be listed in the end of your paper. Any reference cited in the text, should also be present in the reference list and vice versa. Unpublished works or personal forms of communication should not be included in the reference list. For a correct reference system, we suggest you use Mendeley Reference Manager or other reference management packages which may help in managing and writing references.
