Strengthens Innovation in Teacher Education

The University of Elbasan "Aleksandër Xhuvani" participated in the 3rd EduGame Internship for University Professors meeting, organized by Vytautas Magnus University in Kaunas, Lithuania in May 2025. During this intensive week, lecturers from European partner universities and beyond shared ideas, experiences and innovations in the field of gamification, artificial intelligence and digital tools for higher education teaching.

The activities covered topics such as educational escape rooms, prompt engineering for interactive learning, digital teaching tools for STEAM education and Mind Tools.

The participation in this training took place within the framework of the Erasmus+ CBHE EduGame project, which aims to promote inclusive, interactive and future-oriented teaching.

The participation of the University of Elbasan "Aleksandër Xhuvani" in this activity confirms its active role in promoting pedagogical innovation and the integration of new technologies in the educational process.

### Visit and Seminar at the University of Elbasan "Aleksandër Xhuvani", Albania

An official visit of representatives from Vytautas Magnus University, Lithuania, coordinator of the EduGAME Project, Doc. Dr. Judita Kasperiuniene and Dr. Dovile Kuiziniene, was held at the Faculty of Educational Sciences, with the aim of assessing the progress of the project and strengthening cooperation between partners.

During the event, a seminar was organized for employees in the field of education on the topic "Serious Games in Higher Education – from educational games to artificial intelligence." Participants participated in theoretical and practical sessions, developing exercises on gamification of courses and involving students in the learning process.

Representatives of the University of Lithuania also visited the EduGAME Laboratory, where they were introduced to the equipment, teaching materials and demonstrated new ways of using them in teaching.
