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30-31 March 2022, DUBLIN, IRELAND - TRAINING WORKSHOP - DELIVERABLE 2.4

In two intensive days, about 55 academic staff from Albanian Universities and European partners attended the meeting in Dublin, at College of Business, TDU where experts and lectors explained and discussed different theorical and practical issues about benefits of Entrepreneurship Education by Kare Moberg (Senior Researcher, Danish Foundation for Entrepreneurship) or Characteristics of Entrepreneurship (EntreComp), by Professor Tom Cooney, integrating it with Managing Cultural Change at Schools and Universities, Paul O'Reilly (Director, Growth Hub, TU Dublin). Entrepreneurial Learning and Entrepreneurial Teaching Methods were in the focus of the first day followed by the topic: Designing Entrepreneurship Education Programs for Secondary Schools (Junior Achievement Ireland).

The participants learned about how to stimulate Entrepreneurial Behaviour in Primary Schools BY Jerry Kennelly (Founder, Junior Entrepreneur Programme) and how to design Entrepreneurship modules and courses, tools to be used and case studies, other many




